WILLIAM GOLDMAN FOUNDATION

1. The William Goldman Foundation provides a partial scholarship program for graduate and or medical students. Our requirements are:
(1) Applicant must be in the top 1/3 of their class, (2) Must be a full time matriculating graduate student, (3) Must have a great financial need. (4) Student must have completed first year of graduate study.
The Scholarship is awarded in various amounts toward tuition fees only.

The applicant must attend graduate and/or medical school of one of the following institutions: Bryn Mawr College, Drexel University, Drexel University College of Medicine, Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, Temple University, Thomas Jefferson University and Medical College, University of Pennsylvania, or Villanova University.
4. Awards are made annually commencing with the fall semester. There are no mid-year awards.
5. Do not submit the application until you have completed your first year of graduate study at one of the above schools.
6. Applications must be filed no later than March 15, but additional information, such as transcripts and tax returns, may be supplied as late as April 30th.
7. NO APPLICATION, WHETHER A RENEWAL OR AN ORIGINAL APPLICATION WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE MARCH 15TH DEADLINE.
8. If you meet our requirements, you will be requested, by mail, to appear for a personal interview. An interview will not be scheduled for any applicant unless a copy of the applicant's Federal Income Tax Return, your parents Federal Income Tax Return, (even if the applicant is self supporting) for the last calendar year, and a transcript of the final year of undergraduate, and the entire academic record of the graduate school have been submitted.
9. All financial and other information submitted in connection with this scholarship application is for the use of the Foundation only, and will be held in the strictest of confidence.
10. Evaluations will be based primarily upon academic performance, class standing, financial need, and potential future contribution to the Philadelphia community.
11. A new application must be submitted each year for renewal consideration. This renewal application must also be filed no later than March 15th., except for undergraduate transcripts and references, which need not be re-submitted.
12. Applications must be mailed no later than March 15th.

CAMDEN COUNTY BAR FOUNDATION LAW STUDENT AWARDS CRITERIA

BENJAMIN ASBELL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Two scholarship awards of \$1,000 each. One of the awards is restricted to a day or evening student at the Rutgers-Camden School of Law who is a resident of South Jersey and is not a first year student. Applicants must also demonstrate genuine financial need, scholastic ability, and a history or desire to work in the areas of law enforcement and/or the administration of justice. The second of the awards will be given to a student at any of the following law schools: Rutgers-Camden, Rutgers-Newark, Penn, Seton Hall, Temple, Villanova, or Widener.

EIVIND H. BARTH, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a law student attending either the Rutgers-Camden School of Law or the Temple Law School. Applicants should show a bona fide intention to practice law in Camden County and also demonstrate genuine financial need as well as scholastic achievement.

HON. JOSEPH W. COWGILL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a Rutgers-Camden School of Law student who is in the upper half of his or her class. Applicants should demonstrate genuine financial need as well as be a resident of Camden County.

HON. RALPH W.E. DONGES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a part-time evening student at any of the following law schools: Rutgers-Camden, Rutgers-Newark, Penn, Seton Hall, Temple, Villanova, or Widener. Applicants must show a bona fide intention to practice law in Camden County. Applicants should also demonstrate genuine financial need as well as scholastic achievement.

DuBOIS BROTHERS SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a student of any Delaware Valley law school. Applicants must show a bona fide intention to practice law in South Jersey as well as exhibit professionalism and high character in their personal and academic lives. Applicants should also demonstrate genuine financial need.

THOMAS S. HIGGINS IN MEMORIAM AWARD

The ideal candidate for the \$1,000 Thomas S. Higgins, Esquire In Memoriam Law School Award is an outstanding college student from South Jersey, with preference given to candidates from Camden City, has a minimum GPA of 3.5, can demonstrate financial need, and has an interest in public service, with preference given to candidates with an interest in environmental law.

GEORGE F. KUGLER, JR. SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a second or third-year student attending any New Jersey law school. Applicants should demonstrate genuine financial need as well as a history and/or desire to work in public service law.

CHRIS MOURTOS MEMORIAL AWARD

A \$1,000 award available to a full or part-time law student who is not in his/her final year of study. The applicant must be a resident of South Jersey, preferably Camden County, and have demonstrated a commitment to charitable, humanitarian and/or community service activities. To the extent possible, a preference will be given to applicants who graduated from the Camden City public school system. Applicants must also demonstrate genuine financial need.

HAROLD AND HARRIET PLUM MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a student of any accredited law school. Applicants should demonstrate scholastic achievement as well as genuine financial need.

LOUIS C. PORTELLA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a second or third year full-time student at either the Rutgers-Camden or Temple law schools who resides and intends to practice law in Camden County, and who is in good academic standing and active in both extracurricular and community activities. This scholarship is not necessarily based on financial need, but special circumstances will be considered.

HON. RUDOLPH J. ROSSETTI MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a student of any Delaware Valley law school. Applicants should demonstrate scholastic achievement as well as genuine financial need.

DANIEL B. TOLL MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a law student who is not in his or her final year of study. Applicants should be a resident of South Jersey preferably in Camden County and have shown a commitment to the area in charitable, humanitarian, and community service activities.

An official acceptance letter from Rutgers must be submitted with the application form.

BRUCE A. WALLACE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A scholarship of \$1,000 to be given to a third-year student at the Rutgers-Camden School of Law who is from the South Jersey area and is in the upper half of his or her class. Applicants should also demonstrate genuine financial need.
